

Sensory Storytime Program: Bugs

- Hello:
“Good morning. Today we are going to read about bugs!”
- Welcome Rhyme/Song:
“We clap and sing hello
We clap and sing hello
With our friends at Storytime
We clap and sing hello”
- Book: “A Good Place” by Lucy Cousins
- Rhyme: Bug Movement Rhyme
Wiggle like a bug, happy and free! (wiggle)
Flutter like a butterfly, (flutter arms)
Buzz like a bee. (buzz)
Flash like a firefly, (open hands)
Hop like a grasshopper, (jump)
Crawl like a spider. (wiggle 8 fingers)
Wiggle like a bug, happy and free! (wiggle)
- Activity: Caterpillar Color Sorting (Children pick up a foam block or Duplo brick and set it on the correct color segment of the caterpillar.)



- Book: “Bug Dipping, Bug Sipping” by Marilyn Singer
- Song: The Itsy-Bitsy Spider
The itsy-bitsy spider went up the water spout.
Down came the rain, and washed the spider out.
Up came the sun, and dried up all the rain,

and the itsy-bitsy spider went up the spout again.

- Activity: Bug Sensory Bin (Children use tweezers to find the bugs hiding in the grass. Then, use the magnifying glass to determine what it is. Finally, check the bug off on the checklist worksheet.)
